

# Executive Committee

While all of their actions are subject to ratification and review at the Annual Meeting and Conference, most recommendations for actions taken by the Association pass through the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee's responsibilities include the following:

1. Appoint Executive
2. Appoint people to serve on certain Committees.
3. Nominate people to serve on Division.
4. Oversee the work of the entire Association and make financial decisions.
5. Prepare and oversee the Association's annual budget and.
6. Serve as the Board of Directors of the Corporation for the National Association of Congregational Christian Churches.
