Specific programs include but are not limited to the following:

- After school tutoring for elementary and middle school children and English language study for adults.
- Recreational activities for children and youth including athletics, drama, and music.
- Moral and ethical guidance on topics such as gang membership, peer relationships, and bullying.
- Emergency food and clothing distribution to needy families.
- Vocational training and job search assistance as needed.
- Missionary trips to foreign countries coupling educational assistance, needed provisions, and construction projects with the gospel of Jesus.

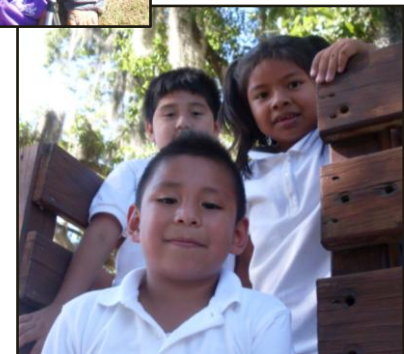

International Missions: Honduras

In 2010 we started a new program to aid in international missions. Currently we are supporting the *Honduras Congregational Mission in San Pedro Sula* through an annual mission trip to assist in educational and provisional needs with the teaching of Jesus Christ.

October 2010 we hosted our first mission trip for the efforts in Honduras. We raised over **300 pairs of new shoes** and joined the *Emmanuel Medical Brigade* of the Honduras Mission to provide for the people of Luquiwie, Yoro an isolated village in the mountainous region of Honduras.

For the Christmas season we go to Dover, Florida where the Strawberry fields are and minister to the migrant farm workers through praise, worship, sharing the Word of God, the act of giving, and soul winning.
