Annual Meeting & Conference Team – Member-at-Large (three-year term; conference calls as needed): This team plans the Annual Meeting & Conference of the NACCC. All others members of the team are positioned by virtue of their office.

Commission on Youth Ministries (CYM) (four-year term; two face-to-face meetings per year in June and Fall with NAPF & HOPE and conference calls as needed): Interest and experience in: ___ youth programming, ___ Assisting in the planning for Youth Leaders retreats, ___ Providing assistance and guidance to NAPF and HOPE Co-Directors, ___ Assisting in providing opportunities for youth in the growth and understanding of Christian life principles for serving the cause of Christ through fellowship and service.

Communication Services Committee (one-year term; renewable up to five (5) years, one face-to-face meeting per year in June and conference calls as needed): Experience in one or more of the following areas: ___ Journalism, ___ Publishing, ___ Editing, ___ Circulation, ___ Public relations, ___ Communications, ___ Marketing.

Congregational Church Development Division (CCD) (four-year term; up to two face-to-face meetings per year in June and Spring or Fall and conference calls as needed): Members should have expertise and interest in one or more of the following: ___ Starting new churches, ___ Fund raising, ___ Church revitalization, ___ Publicity, ___ Identifying and recruiting church planters.

Congregational Foundation for Theological Studies (CFTS) (four-year term; two face-to-face meeting per year in June and Fall and conference calls as needed): For persons who desire to assist, encourage, and mentor students engaged in seminary and/or Congregational studies with an emphasis on training pulpit ministers in the Congregational Way. Experience in: ___ Educational administration, ___ Fund raising, ___ Financial planning and administration, ___ Theological education for laity and toward ordination.

Division for Ministry (DFM) (four-year term; one face-to-face meeting per year in June and conference calls as needed): For persons who are either ordained or laity with an interest in: ___ Pastoral ministry, ___ Assistance programs for Congregational ministries, ___ Congregational and ministerial conflict resolution and management, ___ Search and call procedures.

Missionary Society (MS) (A Division) (four-year term; up to two face-to-face meetings per year in June and Spring or Fall and conference calls as needed): Experience and/or interest in: ___ Missionary work both foreign and domestic, ___ Promulgation of mission programs, ___ Financial acumen and administrative ability.

World Christian Relations Commission (WCRC) (four-year term works almost exclusively online): Up to five persons on this commission charged with creative ways for the NACCC churches to be effective witnesses to the Congregational Way in domestic and foreign ecumenical and interfaith communions.
