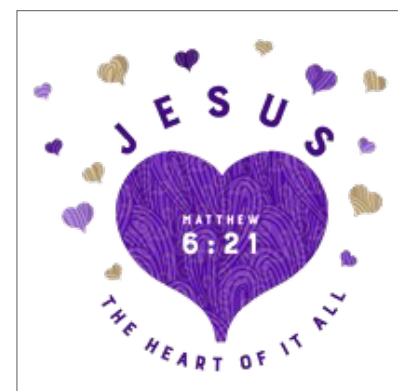
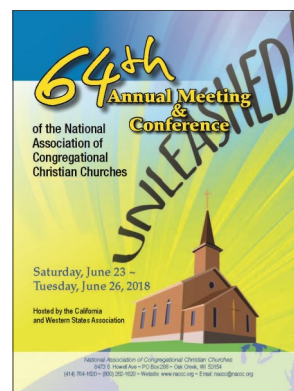
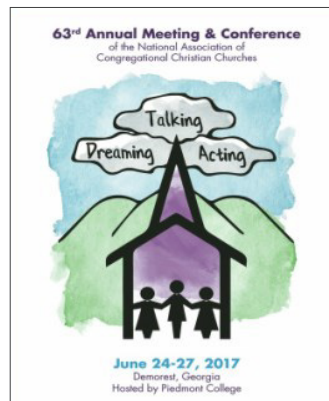
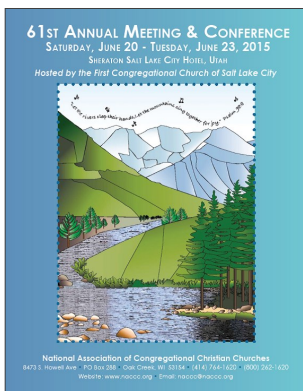
To apply, fill out the Providence Endowment Grant Application form found on our website at [nacc.org](http://nacc.org) and email, fax, or mail it to the NACCC office. Applications must be postmarked before the stated deadline to be considered.

Members of the Growth Ministry Council review all submitted applications and select the recipients based on greatest need. The amount awarded varies depending on the number of applications received and the availability of funds. Awards can be up to \$500.
