What counselors do daily:

- Participate in all program and worship.
- With a co-counselor, to live with and guide a cabin of up to 12 teens (single gender). Includes nightly devotions and discussions (devotions/questions provided).
- Co-lead a small group discussion with a co-ed group of about 8–10 teens after each program session. Discussion material will be provided.
- Participate in one or both organized activities (about 45 minutes) each afternoon. Examples of organized activities include arts and crafts, leading discussion, organizing a volleyball game, etc.

What counselors do once in the week:

- Tell a story around the campfire, relating scripture and God to your life. The story can be from your life but doesn't have to be. Another counselor will also be sharing their story that same night on the same general theme. Usually 10–20 minutes for each counselor.
- Help guide/monitor the teens as they create a cabin skit for Skit Night (Thursday).
- Dress up on Friday night for camp pictures (dress casual)
- Oversee part of the final clean up around the camp.
- Optional: Prepare one 5–7 minute "WWJD experience" for morning or evening worship (including choice of scripture).
