

WHAT WE DO

Establishing & Revitalizing Churches

The National Association of Congregational Christian Churches (NACCC) provides a number of resources to new and growing churches, such as assisting with pastoral searches, building loans, advising services, coaching for church planters, and regional training events.

Leadership Resources

The Center for Congregational Leadership provides seminars and webinars throughout the year for our church leaders and members of the congregation. Past topics included: technology in the church, governance, stewardship, and financial planning.

Mission Opportunities

We partner with and support ten international missions and five national missions. We also have ten recommended missions that do not receive NACCC direct funding, but are supported by member churches.

WHAT IS FAIR SHARE?

The NACCC requires each of our member churches to make an annual contribution to the Shared Ministries Fund, which directly supports our programs and services.

FAIR SHARE refers to the suggested contribution. The NACCC does not require a membership fee, but rather expects that each church support the organization through a gift. Currently, the Fair Share we ask churches to contribute is \$13 a member.

FAIR SHARE PLUS refers to member churches who give at a “Fair Share Plus” level, which is a contribution of \$15 or more a member. This level of giving has a significant impact on the ability of the NACCC to help other member churches.



WHY CONTRIBUTE

As an organization, our vitality is directly tied to the support the member churches provide. The NACCC exists to serve churches and relies on financial contributions to carry out the various programs and services.
