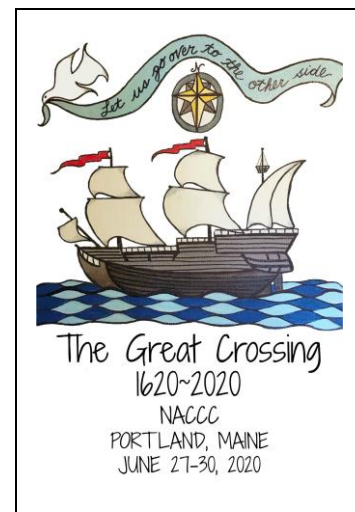


THE OFFICIAL CALL OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CONGREGATIONAL CHRISTIAN CHURCHES
