Recently, we discovered that several requirements had been asked of MOMC in the past that we have not been following. We have reinstated "Quarterly Reports" asking all missions to submit to us a list of how NA money has been spent and receipts to go with that list. At the end of each fiscal year, each mission will be asked to submit an annual report, detailing their needs and goals for the following year. We are happy to provide funding for many of those goals which match our goals. There are missions that struggle to do a good job reporting. Work continues to help them understand this accounting.

We have been especially proud of Matthew Oladele's work in at Christ of the Villages in Nigeria. Matthew and his wife asked for support from us to establish a cashew farm that the hope will eventually make the communities self-supporting. He had planned to be with us to give us his report and show us pictures of the farm and does plan to come next year and meet with us in Spokane, and the pictures we have seen so far are wonderful.

ECHO continues its work to teach sustainable hunger solutions and several of our missionaries have been to their workshops and taken ideas home to their communities. We are proud to see missions we support working with each other.

The Congregational Church of Myanmar is celebrating 20 years of service this year and we will honor them with a plaque recognizing their work. Also, the Rev. Charles Nyane needed help covering medical expenses and we were able to help him with that payment.

It is such a joyful time to write about what happened this past year at our missions. I suspect, with the coronavirus infecting the whole world's population, we will see many more requests for help in the upcoming fiscal year. Thank you for honoring us with your dollars to do God's work in His Kingdom.
