### **PROPOSED 2020 STANDING RULES FOR VIRTUAL ANNUAL MEETING**

A “Virtual” Annual Meeting will be held by the National Association of Congregational Christian church on Saturday, June 27, 2020. The following Standing Rules are proposed to conduct that meeting.

- Only registered Delegates (or Alternate Delegates (if the Delegate is unavailable) will be allowed to vote on NACCC motions.
- To obtain the floor, a person should “virtually” raise their hand and be recognized by the presiding officer, and then give his/her name and church affiliation before speaking.
- No person shall speak in debate more than once on the same question or longer than one minute.
- The presiding officer shall require that all motions be in writing. Any motions that were not emailed to Carrie Dahm at the NACCC National office prior to the Thursday, June 25, 2020 deadline, that must be addressed, may be submitted to the Secretary and Moderator through “Chat” on the “Zoom” site during the meeting.
- The proceeding of the Annual Meeting shall be governed by the rules in the current edition of “Robert’s Rules of Order” newly revised in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with the bylaws of the National Association, including the temporary emergency bylaws allowing the “Virtual” annual meeting approved by the Board of Directors on May 11, 2020 or these standing rules.
