At our monthly meetings, we have been brainstorming other ways that we can be a resource to our diverse congregations. One idea that is in the works is developing a technological pay-it-forward fund. We have not received any applicants recently but encourage you to get the word out to churches about the purpose of this fund, which is "to assist member churches of the National Association of Congregational Christian Churches (NACCC) through challenging times." This quote, along with the application details, are available on the NACCC website, which, if you have not seen it recently, has been revamped!

One of the areas which GMC oversees is the publication of the devotionals that come out twice a year. There are a few people (other than the writers, of course) whose efforts make this such a success. Along with fellow GMC member Carol Taylor, kudos go out to Terry Bobzien and Casey vanderBent. They make it look easy, but we all know that this is a Herculean task. One of the best bits of feedback we have received is that people use these devotionals throughout the year — not just during Advent and Lent. They are truly a treasure trove of spiritual nourishment.
