Themes

For 2024, each edition of *The Congregationalist* will have an assigned theme. These themes are intended to be broad guideposts for submission content. Assigned themes do not need to be the central or sole focus of submissions - we simply ask that articles submitted for any given edition relate to the theme of that edition in some capacity.

The themes of the 2024 editions are as follows:

- March: Faith
- June: Freedom
- September: Fellowship
- December: Giving

Categories of Submissions

Areas of interest for *The Congregationalist* include, but are not limited to, the following topics as they relate to an edition's theme:

- Reflections on Scripture
- Explorations of Religious Rituals and Practices
- Historical and Cultural Perspectives
- Theological Interpretations
- Book Reviews or Recommendations
- Personal Testimonies
- Art, Music, Storytelling, and Other Creative Expressions
- Resources and Tools for Spiritual Growth

Process and Timeline

In order to allow time for the planning of the magazine's content and structure, we ask that those interested in contributing to the magazine express their intention to do so via email to the editor by the Intention to Contribute Deadline for the edition they intend to contribute to. The 2024 deadlines are as follows:

- March Issue:
 - Intention to Contribute Deadline: January 1
 - Finalized Submission Deadline: January 15

- June Issue:
 - Intention to Contribute Deadline: April 1
 - Finalized Submission Deadline: April 15
- September Issue:
 - Intention to Contribute Deadline: July 1
 - Finalized Submission Deadline: July 15
- December Issue:
 - Intention to Contribute Deadline: October 1
 - Finalized Submission Deadline: October 15

Emails of this nature can be as simple as sharing a few sentences about who you are, the topic of your prospective contribution, and the type of contribution you intend to submit (i.e., a book review, a historical account, etc.).

Those who indicate their intent to contribute will be provided with guidelines for their submission. Authors' finalized contributions should be submitted to the editor via email no later than the Finalized Submission Deadline for the issue they intend to contribute to.
